Power Need

Baldwin City Public Works is in charge of all things citywide related to power. Located in Kansas, they are a municipally owned utility that was established in 1904. They own five Fairbanks Morse (FM) units including two 10 cylinder FM 38 DD 8-1/8, one 12 cylinder FM 38 TDD 8-1/8, and two 12 cylinder FM 38 ETDD 8-1/8. Baldwin City has used FM Factory-Certified Technicians during maintenance inspections and to assist them when issues occur that they are not able to resolve on their own.

Recently, Baldwin experienced an issue with a gas valve actuator on one of their engines.
